Aeronautical Development Agency, (ADA), an autonomous Body and a Society under Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India, entrusted with the task of Design and Development of Light Combat Aircraft (LCA – Tejas). ADA is in need of bright, young and energetic engineers for Project Fellowship as Project Assistants, as per the details given below:-

Age	Upto 28 years (as on the date of registration of application) Relaxation of age allowed as per Govt. of India Rules for reserved categories.
Essential Qualification	FIRST CLASS Graduate Degree in Engineering / Technology (BE/B.Tech) in the areas of Aeronautical / Aerospace / Mechanical / Electronics & Communication / Telecommunication / Electronics & Instrumentation / Electrical & Electronics / Computer Science / Information Technology / Information Science / Metallurgy / Structural Engg) with minimum 60% Marks or 6.75 CGPA WITH a valid GATE Score. OR Graduate Degree in Engineering / Technology (BE/B.Tech) in the areas as mentioned above WITH Post-Graduate Degree in Engineering / Technology (ME/M.Tech) in FIRST CLASS both at Graduate and Post-Graduate level.
Stipend	Rs. 25,000/- pm (likely to be revised) plus HRA as per rules.
Tenure	Initially for two years, extendable as per rules and/or requirement of the project.

General Conditions :-

- 1. Project Assistant is a defined tenure based Fellowship and does not confer any right for a regular / permanent appointment in ADA.**
2. Candidates should have completed their respective Degree in Engineering / Technology in the disciplines / combination of disciplines as mentioned above with minimum 60% Marks or 6.75 CGPA and should either be in possession of valid GATE score **OR** Master's Degree in Engineering / Technology in **FIRST CLASS** both at Graduate and Post-Graduate level as on the date of registration of application on ADA web site.

3. The candidate should note that the Validity period as mentioned in the GATE score card is taken into consideration as on the date of registration of application. If the candidate has entered GATE Scores of more than one year, then the score card having higher valid GATE score will be considered for processing.
4. Minimum class & percentage of marks required to be eligible for applying for Project Assistant is First Class with 60% marks or 6.75 CGPA. (The candidate has to produce a conversion formula as given by the concerned university for conversion of CGPA to percentage marks establishing that he/she has secured a minimum 60 percent marks in his/her UG / PG)
5. Candidates should register their application in the area of their BE/B.Tech or ME/M.Tech Engineering subject only.
6. The candidates should fulfil the requisite qualification as per para 1 above as on the date of registration of application. The short listed candidates will be called for interview to be conducted as per the requirement of ADA, in Bangalore.
7. The eligibility requirements like age, qualification, GATE score and validity is determined as on the date of successful registration of application on ADA web site.
8. Candidates should upload all relevant documents in proof of details furnished by them in the on-line application.
9. Candidates have to produce all relevant original documents in proof of details furnished in their application submitted on-line at the time of interview. If any information furnished online is found to be wrong, the candidates will not be allowed for interview
10. Age relaxation allowed as per Govt. of India Rules for reserved categories.
11. Candidates already working in Govt/Semi Govt./PSUs/Autonomous Bodies should produce No Objection Certificate (NOC) when they appear for interview (incase if they are shortlisted).
12. Candidates already working as Project Assistants/Junior Research Fellows/Project Fellow/ Research Fellow may also apply for the same, provided that whatever fellowship period left out will be offered in ADA.
13. Interview call letters for short listed candidates will be forwarded by e-mail only. Hence candidates may correctly fill the e-mail id & Mobile Number. No queries in this regard will be entertained on telephone.
14. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.
15. If any information furnished online is found to be incorrect, the candidature is treated as cancelled.

17. There is no last date prescribed in the advertisement for registration of application on ADA web site. However, ADA will short-list the eligible applications periodically, depending on availability of vacancies and requirement from time to time.

How to apply:-

1. Candidates are requested register their application on www.ada.gov.in. Application received from any other source will be rejected.

2. On registration, applicants will be provided with an on-line Registration Number which should be quoted for future reference.

3. The candidates are required to upload the following documents compulsorily.

(a) Scanned photo of size 110Wx140H px (Image JPEG/JPG). **(File size not exceeding 25KB)**

(b) Scanned legible copies of the following certificates in **ONE SINGLE PDF FILE (File size not exceeding 1MB)**

(i) 10th std certificate

(ii) Degree Certificate / Provisional Degree Certificate

(iii) Last semester marks card (only if class of passing the Degree not mentioned in the certificate)

(iv) Caste certificate (applicable only incase of upper age relaxation)

(c) GATE Score Card **OR** ME/M.Tech certificate with last Semester marks card (for candidates not having GATE Score) in **ONE SINGLE PDF FILE (File size not exceeding 1MB)**
